INSIGHTS

- 1. Out of 38 Judges, Uttarakhand has had only one female judge
- 2. On the face of it, Uttarakhand has had only one Muslim judge
- 3. Around 19 Judges have Uttarakhand as their Parent High Court itself
- 4. Out of 38, only 6Judges have been elevated to the SC
- 5. Most of the judges' law degree year is not available, but a lot of their law degree institutions are available
- 6. The state bar associations where the judges were enrolled are also hard to come by, available for only a handful (I have noticed this throughout the 3 high courts)
- 7. None of the judges have had a foreign degree in law
- 8. Only 4 judges have a postgraduate degree in law (one of them being the female judge)
- 9. DOB of all judges is available, unlike Jharkhand
- 10. Only 2 Judges' chamber details are available
- 11. Maybe only 2 judges (comments have been added in the sheet) were empanelled by private companies
- 12. Only one judge has served as an Advocate General
- 13. One Judge was enrolled in the Lincoln's Inn in UK, but his details of enrolment for India are unavailable
