

INSIGHTS

1. Out of 38 Judges, Uttarakhand has had only one female judge
2. On the face of it, Uttarakhand has had only one Muslim judge
3. Around 19 Judges have Uttarakhand as their Parent High Court itself
4. Out of 38, only 6 Judges have been elevated to the SC
5. Most of the judges' law degree year is not available, but a lot of their law degree institutions are available
6. The state bar associations where the judges were enrolled are also hard to come by, available for only a handful (I have noticed this throughout the 3 high courts)
7. None of the judges have had a foreign degree in law
8. Only 4 judges have a postgraduate degree in law (one of them being the female judge)
9. DOB of all judges is available, unlike Jharkhand
10. Only 2 Judges' chamber details are available
11. Maybe only 2 judges (comments have been added in the sheet) were empanelled by private companies
12. Only one judge has served as an Advocate General
13. One Judge was enrolled in the Lincoln's Inn in UK, but his details of enrolment for India are unavailable~
