

Insights: High Court of Meghalaya

- The High Court of Meghalaya came into existence on 23rd March 2013. Prior to that, the Shillong Bench of the High Court of Gauhati was representative of the State of Meghalaya.
- The Sikkim High Court/ the High Court of Meghalaya is the smallest High Court of India with a sanctioned court strength of 3 judges.
- Since 2013, Justice T. Meena Kumari has been the only female judge in Meghalaya. She had also been its Chief Justice.
- Since 2013, out of all the judges appointed at the Meghalaya High Court, there are only two whose parent high court is that of Meghalaya.
- Justice Prafulla Chandra Pant and Justice Dinesh Maheshwari, both serving as Chief Justice of the Meghalaya High Court have gone on to ascend to the Supreme Court of India.
